NO MARTINGALES IN HACK AND FLAT CLASSES

COMPETITORS MAY SCHOOL HORSES BEFORE THE SHOW.

WARM-UP over fences in competitive arena: From 7:30 – 8:15 promptly. Fee \$10.00/horse.

Tickets for a 2-minute warmup round may be purchased with your entry or at the show office.

All competitors may use “Warm-up areas” next to show arena for no charge.

Longing may be done in warm-up arena if there is space.

All classes are Walk-Trot-Canter except Short and Long Stirrup

Please enter classes that are appropriate for the rider’s and horse’s levels of experience.

JUMPS IN HUNTER CLASSES MAY BE COLORED FENCES

Long Stirrup/Walk/Trot: No restrictions. If number of entries warrant, class will be divided by rider’s age.

Short Stirrup Division: For beginner riders 11 & under. Riders may not enter any other classes. Riders in this division are not penalized for trotting.

****Jumper Classes:** Knockdowns only – timed first round; fastest clean round wins.

STALLIONS MAY NOT BE SHOWN BY JUNIORS (18 years and under).

ALL DOGS MUST BE LEASHED.

NO OPEN FIRES OR BAR-B-QUE.

We understand that running two arenas simultaneously presents the potential for class conflicts. We would appreciate it if the riders who share horses would keep this in mind when planning their class schedules. We will try to be as accommodating as possible, while keeping in mind the needs of the other competitors and the judges. Therefore we will not hold a class for more than 5 minutes. If you are unable to compete in a class because of a conflict, the secretary will refund your class fee.
