

Minutes of July 9, 2005  
Woodside Pony Club Meeting

I. The minutes from the last meeting were approved.

II. Treasurer's Report from Belinda Hanson: Belinda submitted the balance sheet and profit and loss statement. Everything is good. She is putting together a spread sheet and is almost done. The Club's non profit status form is current.

III. Summer riding: Susan Robertson and Catherine Swent met with Hope Sullivan who works for the Town of Woodside. The Pony Club Use Permit with the Town allows riding on Tripp Rd. during June, July, and August only during Saturday's from 9AM to 6PM. The Club needs to amend the permit in September at the next Town Council meeting. There are certain forms that we need to file. The other clubs with whom we share Tripp Rd. are in support of the permit change, so it should go OK. We need to get a current copy of the file that the Town has--this has been requested. Alternatives to riding on Tripp Rd. are Bullock's (\$10), CTETA (\$30), and Sommer's Field(\$20 with \$50 annual fee).

IV. Horse Management Program (HM): This program goes from September through May. Lora Quinlin is getting binders for HM. (Rosemary Broome does the cost/activity binders for Pony Club.) Belinda Hanson offered to photocopy the binders at her office, if Lora would provide a master copy. We currently need to new sets of binders.

V. Ratings: The Club needs a rating coordinator for this fall. Nancy Ridgway volunteered to be the ratings coordinator. Patty Cooley said she would also help. Ratings will be held this fall.
